<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>2 ft. H x 2 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Mat forming, vigorous rhizomes</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Umbels of light to dark pink flowers</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Narrow, fern-like, green</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>CA, Western US, Europe, western Asia</b>

## **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>1-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well-drained, neutral</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Moderate</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Part shade in hottest climates</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Deadhead for continued bloom. Divide every 2-3 years to keep vigorous.</b>
