Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Mat forming, vigorous rhizomes
Flower / Fruit:	Umbels of white flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Narrow, fern-like, green
Native To:	California, Europe, western Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained, neutral
Water:	Low - Moderate
Sun:	Full sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	Can mow or weedeat dead blooms if needed. May become semi-deciduous in summer with very low water.

Good lawn substitute. Attractive to butterflies and beneficial insects. Deer resistant
