

Agave americana Century Plant



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Succulent Perennial Drought Resistant
Height / Width:	5-6 ft. H x 10 ft. W
Plant Form:	Architectural, sculptural
Flower / Fruit:	After 10 years or more, produces branched, 15-40 ft. high flower stalk with yellowish green flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Blue-green, fleshy, 6 ft. long w/hooked spines along margins and a wicked spike at tip
Native To:	Southwest U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	10, 12-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Low to moderate Do not overwater
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Allow plenty of room away from foot traffic
