## Parry's Agave



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Drought Resistant Succulent Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>3 ft. H x 3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Architectural, sculptural</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>When about 20 years old, plants push up a stout stalk with clusters of yellow flowers</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Thick, blue-green or gray- green leaves are tipped with sharp black spines.</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Arizona, New Mexico and Northern Mexico</b>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>2b, 3, 6-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Not fussy</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Low</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun to partial shade</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Spreads by offsets to form colonies.</b>
