PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1-2 ft. H x Spreading
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	Ornamental clusters of bulbets in summer that fall over and plant themselves, thereby 'walking' around in the garden!
Leaf:	Gray-green, flat
Native To:	Southeastern Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Low-Moderate (will spread vigorously with regular water)
Sun:	Full sun to Part Shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back after foliage dies

GARDEN USE

In borders and as cut flowers. Leaves and bulbets can be used to season soups & salads.
