

Amaryllis belladonna Naked Ladies



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial from bulb

Height / Width: 1 ft. H x 2 ft. W

Plant Form: Flowering bulb

Flower / Fruit: About 6 weeks after foliage dies back, 2-3 ft. stalks rise from the bare earth, each topped by a cluster of 4-12 fragrant trumpet-shaped, rosy pink flowers

Leaf Color, Size: Bold, strap-like leaves form clump in fall and winter; foliage dies back by early summer.

Native To: South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 4-24

Soil: Well-drained average

Water: No irrigation needed

Sun: Full sun

Care and Pruning: Lift and divide clumps rarely; they may not bloom for several years if disturbed at the wrong time.

GARDEN USE Large containers; naturalized plantings
