PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Herbaceous Perennial

Height / Width: 1.5 ft. H x 2 ft. W

Plant Form: Spreading mat

Flower / Fruit: White, odd, one-foot high, cone-shaped in spring, early summer

Leaf: Large, waxy, dull gray-green leaves that lay flat and forms mats that from a distance look like a permanent pasture

Native To: Southwest U.S. northern Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 1-24

Soil: Tolerant of heavy soils, sand

Water: Regular to ample

Sun: Partial sun

Care and Pruning: Spreads by stolons; prune or mow in late summer
