PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	4-6 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Loose, branching
Flower / Fruit:	Masses of blue-violet flowers on erect, wiry, wine red stems in late summer to early fall
Leaf Color, Size:	Heart-shaped
Native To:	Eastern North America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10, 14-21
Soil:	Best growth in fertile soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Divide in late fall or early spring. Dig out unwanted spreading in early spring.

GARDEN USE

Abundant late season color in large borders or among shrubs. Large sprays effective in arrangements.
