

Caesalpinia gilliesii

Yellow Bird of Paradise



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen to deciduous shrub or tree; drops leaves in cold winters

Height/Width: 10 ft. H x 8 ft. W; fast growing

Plant Form: Open, angular branch structure

Flower / Fruit: Clusters of yellow flowers adorned with bright red stamens; blooms all summer. Blooms several times during season - after an infrequent deep watering.

Leaf: Finely cut foliage

Native To: South America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 8-16, 18-24

Soil: Light, well-drained

Water: Infrequent and deep

Sun: Hot, sunny locations

Care and Pruning: Prune before first flush of spring growth to remove any dead or damaged wood.
