Curly Blonde Sedge



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Grass-like Perennial
Height / Width:	1.5-2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Clump-forming, fine textured
Flower / Fruit:	Inconspicuous
Leaf Color, Size:	Silvery-green, very narrow recurving leaf blades, hair-like "curls" occur as the blades die and curve back toward the base
Native To:	New Zealand

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-9, 14-24
Soil:	Prefers moist, fertile soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Part shade
Care and Pruning:	Run a rake through it in late winter to remove old foliage. Can divide in spring.
