PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Grass-like Perennial
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x 1.5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Clump forming
Flower / Fruit:	Small brownish flowers in late spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Drooping leaves striped pale yellow and green
Native To:	Japan

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-9, 14-24
Soil:	Moist soil or normal garden soil
Water:	Regular, soil must not be allowed to dry out
Sun:	Shade in hottest climates
Care / Pruning:	Cut foliage back in Feb - Mar
