PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Grass-like Perennial
Height / Width:	2 ft. H x 3-5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Widely arching, dense tuft
Flower / Fruit:	Light golden brown clusters in spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Green below with bright red & orange highlights in good light
Native To:	New Zealand

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-9, 14-24
Soil:	Tolerant of many types
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back flowerheads after bloom to avoid self-seeding
