

# **Carpenteria californica**

## **Bush Anemone**



### **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Evergreen shrub

**Height/Width:** 4-6 ft. H x 4-6 ft. W

**Plant Form:** Upright with many stems

**Flower / Fruit:** Delicate, scented, white with yellow centers at branch ends, in late spring and summer

**Leaf:** Thick, narrow, dark green above and whitish beneath

**Native To:** Foothills of southern Sierra Nevada in California's Central Valley

### **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 5-9, 14-24

**Soil:** Well drained soil

**Water:** Little to moderate

**Sun:** Partial shade in hottest climates

**Care and Pruning:** Prune after flowering, inspect new growth occasionally for pests, resistant to oak root fungus

**GARDEN USE** Shrub borders, native gardens

**BOTANICAL GARDEN** Urban Forest, Celebration Garden
