Buttonbush, Buttonwillow



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous shrub or tree
Height / Width:	3-5 ft. H or more x 3-5 ft. W or more
Plant Form:	Rounded, open, upright
Flower / Fruit:	Clusters of creamy white 1-in. blooms in late summer; look like pin cushions, mature into décor- ative reddish fruits
Leaf Color, Size:	Bright green, paired, whorled 2-6 in. long, leafs out late in spring
Native To:	Western North America

Sunset Zones:	2-10, 14-21
Soil:	Heavy, moist
Water:	Regular to ample
Sun:	Part shade to full sun
Care / Pruning:	Will form large stands
