Plant Type:	Annual; tender perennial
Height / Width:	3-6 ft. H x varies
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	Long spikes of delicate, 3-in. long lavender "foxgloves"
Leaf Color, Size:	Ovate to three-lobed, green
Native To:	South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

USDA Zones:	9, 10
Soil:	Rich, well-drained
Water:	Looks best with moderate water. Drought tolerant.
Sun:	Shade to partial shade in hottest climates. Heat tolerant.
Care / Pruning:	Reseeds freely
