

# Cercis canadensis

## Eastern Redbud



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Tree
Height / Width:	25-35 ft. H x 25-35 ft. W
Plant Form:	Round headed, often multi-stemmed, with horizontally tiered branches in age
Flower / Fruit:	Rosy pink flowers in spring, then clusters of flat beanlike pods lasting into winter
Leaf Color, Size:	Rich green, 3-6 in.-long with pointed tips
Native To:	Eastern U.S.

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Fertile, moist, well-drained, will tolerate a range of types
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Do any pruning in dormant season after bloom
