PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial Grass
Height / Width:	5 ft. H x 1-2.5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Clumping, arching
Flower / Fruit:	Arching stems bearing showers of silvery green spikelets resembling flattened clusters of oats, turning copper in fall and persisting through winter
Leaf Color, Size:	Broad, bamboo-like
Native To:	Eastern U.S. moist woodlands

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-10, 14-24
Soil:	Moist, well-drained, regular soil
Water:	Regular water
Sun:	Partial shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Cut back near the ground before winter, divide when flowering diminishes
