PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Drought resistant Perennial
Height / Width:	2-4 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Flowering bulb
Flower / Fruit:	Dainty, white, fly-away petals on 5 ft. stalk; open at the end of the day, closing the next morning
Leaf Color, Size:	1 to 2 ft. green wavy leaves in early spring, with basal leaves spread along the ground
Native To:	Southern Oregon through California

Sunset Zones:	4-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Low to no water
Sun:	Full sun, part shade
Care and Pruning:	Minimal
