PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Annual / Tender Perennial – Reseeds
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clumps
Flower / Fruit:	Branching stems are hung with drooping 1 1/2" bright orange and yellow flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Rich green, heart shaped leaves
Native To:	Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	11-13, 21-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Shade to mostly shade in hottest areas
Care and Pruning:	Easy to grow, re-seeds readily. Deadhead as needed.

Borders, mass plantings, containers. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
