Tufted Hair Grass



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Ornamental Grass Evergreen except in colder climates
Height/Width:	1-2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Clump-forming graceful fountain
Flower / Fruit:	Tall sprays of airy green to greenish gold flowers in late spring-early summer to 4 ft. high, turning to straw color in winter
Leaf:	Narrow, dark green
Native To:	North America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Tolerant of many types; prefers moist, organically rich soils
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun to part shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Cut old foliage to ground in late winter before new shoots appear.

GARDEN USE

Excellent massed in woodland gardens or naturalized areas. Effective as a specimen, or in moist areas along ponds or streams.
