## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1-1.5 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Graceful, trailing mound
Flower / Fruit:	Dainty, $\frac{3}{4}$ -in. daisy-like with numerous white or pinkish rays, yellow centers; almost always in bloom
Leaf Color, Size:	Green, narrow, semi-evergreen
Native To:	Mexico

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8, 9, 12-24
Soil:	Fast-draining
Water:	Moderate to irregular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Shear occasionally to keep covered in blooms. Cut to ground in winter.

Groundcover, edging, rock gardens, large containers, hanging baskets, dry walls
