### **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Drought resistant Perennial shrub</b>
<b>Height/Width:</b>	<b>3 ft. H x 3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Large shrub</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Long-stalked, flat clusters of pale pink to rose flowers, late spring through summer</b>
<b>Leaf:</b>	<b>Narrow, 1/2 to 1 1/2" long gray-green leaves cluster at ends of branches</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Channel Islands of California</b>

### **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>5, 7-9, 14-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Not fussy</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Low</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Withstands wind and heat well. Very low maintenance. Self-sows.</b>
