PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Shrub
Height / Width:	Can reach 15-20 ft. High and Wide
Plant Form:	Dense, twiggy flat-topped shrub with horizontal branching
Flower / Fruit:	Yellow-green inflorescences; fruit inconspicuous hidden in foliage
Leaf Color, Size:	Dark green leaves spring through summer, turning bright, clear red in the fall
Native To:	China, Japan, Korea

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-10, 14-16
Soil:	Well-drained, slightly acidic
Water:	Moderate to regular water
Sun:	Full to part sun
Care and Pruning:	Prune as needed for structure. Urban stress tolerant
GARDEN USE	Excellent specimen plant as well good choice formal or informal hedge
