

# Euphorbia cyparissias

## Cypress Spurge



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial (rhizomatous) May go dormant in winter
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x spreads vigorously
Plant Form:	Feathery lax clump
Flower / Fruit:	Terminal clusters of yellow-green flowers in late spring to early summer (may turn orange in poor soils)
Leaf:	Blue-green, needle-like
Native To:	Europe

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Well drained
Water:	Little to moderate
Sun:	Full sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	<b>Milky white sap is irritating to skin, toxic if ingested. Wear long sleeves and gloves when cutting back.</b>

### GARDEN USE

Useful groundcover for areas receiving irregular irrigation or under oak trees. Plant under taller plants.
