PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Perennial
Height / Width:	2 ft. H x 3-5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Broad, domed clusters, in late winter, early spring, chartreuse yellow fading to pinkish
Leaf Color, Size:	Fleshy gray-green, to 1½ in. long, narrow and pointed, set tightly against stems that angle outward, then rise upward
Native To:	Mediterranean

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Drought tolerant
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Milky white sap is irritating to skin, toxic if ingested. Wear long sleeves and gloves when pruning. Cut yellowed stalks out at base
