PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height/Width:	2.5-4 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Airy clump with deep taproot
Flower / Fruit:	Pinkish buds along wiry, erect, wand-like stems open to white flowers which slowly fade to pink. Blooms from late spring into fall.
Leaf:	Small green, lance-shaped, stemless
Native To:	Texas, Louisiana

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate, but drought-tolerant
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Remove seed-bearing spikes to prolong bloom period, and pre-vent enthusiastic self-sowing.

GARDEN USE	Wildflower or native plant gardens, and allowed to sprawl & naturalize. Effective in sunny borders.
