PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	6-8 ft. H x 4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Broom-like shrub
Flower / Fruit:	Covered with narrow clusters of fragrant small, dainty white flowers at shoot tips. Blooms May - Sept
Leaf Color, Size:	Slender, flexible, silvery gray branches with silvery gray slender leaves
Native To:	South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-9, 16-26
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Average, do not overwater
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Cut back hard as needed after winter to encourage bushiness and more flowers for the following season
