PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x 3-5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Low, compact, spreading
Flower / Fruit:	Very showy pink and white, blooms February-December!
Leaf Color, Size:	Gray-green soft needles
Native To:	Hybrid, originally from Australia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	6-9, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained, tolerant of fertility
Water:	Little water, drought-tolerant
Sun:	Full sun, partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Fast growing. Prune after flowering to shape. Fertilize if needed with low-phosphate fertilizer
