PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	5 ft. H x 8 ft. W
Plant Form:	Medium sized dense shrub
Flower / Fruit:	Deep rose red blossoms fall through spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Fine textured half-inch long gray leaves
Native To:	Hybrid, originally from Australia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	15-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Low
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Moderate growing. Can be kept compact with heavy pruning. Low- or no-phosphate fertilizer only.

Dense grower for bank or slope. Good container plant. Attracts hummingbirds.
