PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial (rhizomatous)
Height / Width:	18-30 in. x 18 in. W
Plant Form:	Upright Fan
Flower:	See Photo. Flowers have a delicious grape soda fragrance.
Leaf:	White variegation on broad gray-green, sword-like leaves
Native To:	Garden hybrid

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Tolerant of many soils if drainage is good
Water:	At least once per week deep watering during blooming period then every 10 days after bloom
Sun:	Full sun to afternoon shade
Care and Pruning:	Set out Sept-Oct, 1-2 ft. apart with tops barely above surface. Feed with green sand or high phosphorus fertilizer in early spring (Feb-Mar). Lift and divide every 3-4 years (in Aug-Oct), discarding old ones
