PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial (rhizomatous)
Height / Width:	3-5 ft. H x 1-2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, dense clump
Flower / Fruit:	Bright yellow, 3-4 in. wide flowers on tall 4-7 ft. high stems with delicate light-brownish to purple veins or flecks
Leaf Color, Size:	Flattened fans, raised midrib, sword-like, fine-pointed, 3-4 ft.
Native To:	Europe

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Acidic, moist, high nitrogen
Water:	Low to regular
Sun:	Sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	Spreads by underground roots and floating seeds. Dense colonies can become invasive with ample water.

GARDEN USE Impressive foliage plant. Thrives in shallow water.
