PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Perennial
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x 1 ft. W
Plant Form:	Erect, grass-like clumps
Flower / Fruit:	Feathery, clustered near stem tips
Leaf Color, Size:	Long, needle-like, blue-gray
Native To:	California and Oregon

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-9, 14-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Moderate to ample
Sun:	Full sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Tolerant of more heat and drought than other rushes

GARDEN USE

Great for moist or wet areas at edge of pond or stream, in water, or among stones and pebbles, containers; deer resistant
