Iringleaf Rush



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Perennial
Height / Width:	1-2 ft. H x spreading
Plant Form:	Low, spreads by rhizomes
Flower / Fruit:	Attractive globular heads of dark brown seedheads
Leaf Color, Size:	Iris-like leaf blades, up to ½-in.-wide at base.
Native To:	California, in wet places from sea level to 7000 ft.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	Cold hardy to 15°F
Soil:	Adapts to soils
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Sun or shade
Care and Pruning:	Prune spent leaves as needed.

GARDEN USE

Extremely adaptable, grows in all conditions from bog to desert! Interesting grass for wet areas.
