

Lavandula 'Goodwin Creek Grey' Lavender hybrid



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen shrub
Height/Width:	3 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Dense mound
Flower / Fruit:	Deep violet-blue spires, spring through late fall
Leaf:	Silvery, toothed at tips
Native To:	Hybrid of <i>L. lanata</i> & <i>L. dentata</i>

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8, 9, 12-24
Soil:	Loose, fast draining soil
Water:	Low-moderate, drought tolerant Roots will rot if overwatered
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Prune after bloom to shape plant. Little or no fertilizer. Mulch with pea gravel rather than wood chips.

GARDEN USE

Large containers, sunny paths, topiary. Cut flower, or dried arrangements and sachets. Attractive to bees & butterflies.
