

Lavandula stoechas

Spanish Lavender



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen shrub

Height / Width: 1.5 - 3 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W

Plant Form: Stocky

Flower / Fruit: Blackish maroon, on short 2 in. spikes, topped by two to four flag-like purple to pink bracts, spring into summer

Leaf Color/Size: Narrow gray or gray-green

Native To: Mediterranean regions

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 4-24

Soil: Not fussy

Water: Little to moderate

Sun: Full sun

Care and Pruning: Prune immediately after bloom to keep plants compact and promote repeat bloom. Can reseed vigorously.

GARDEN USE Hedge or edging in herb gardens or in borders with plants needing similar conditions; sachets
