**PLANT DESCRIPTION**

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Drought resistant Biennial, short-lived perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>2-3 ft. H x 1-2 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Upright</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Pink and white velvety 1-inch flowers open one at a time and last only a day; from late spring to early fall</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Silky silver leaves with widely branched stems</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Southeastern Europe</b>

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>1-9, 14-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Sandy to poor, dry soil</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Low</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun, partial shade</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Short lived, but self-sows freely Deadhead spent flowers if re- seeding undesirable</b>
