

Myrtus communis 'Boetica' Twisted Myrtle



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Drought resistant Evergreen shrub or small tree
Height / Width:	12 ft. H x 12 ft. W
Plant Form:	Irregular, contorted shape
Flower / Fruit:	Fragrant white flowers, spring through summer, followed by bluish black berries
Leaf Color, Size:	Pointed, glossy dark green, larger than typical myrtles; pleasantly aromatic when brushed or bruised
Native To:	Mediterranean

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8–24
Soil:	Any soil with good drainage
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade
Care/Pruning:	Selective pruning winter to early spring
