Hooker's Evening Primrose



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1-4' H x 1-2' W
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	2-3 inch blossoms carried in terminal spikes open pale yellow, later turn orange red.
Leaf Color, Size:	Basal rosette of medium green, lance-shaped 2-5 inch long leaves
Native To:	Moist places in Western U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	5-7, 14-24
Soil:	Moist, well-drained soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Reseeds heavily; not recommended for orderly, irrigated garden.
