**PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Shrubby perennial

**Height / Width:** 3 ft. H x 3 ft. W

**Plant Form:** Spreading

**Flower / Fruit:** Pink, in small clusters

**Leaf:** Large soft lemon-scented leaves on robust plant are main attraction

**Native To:** South Africa - species

**GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 8, 9, 12-14, 18-21

**Soil:** Good drainage

**Water:** Low to Moderate

**Sun:** Afternoon shade in hot climates

**Care and Pruning:** Pinch growing tips of young plants to force side branching. Cut back as needed in winter.

**GARDEN USE** Good container plant, herb gardens, edgings, window boxes, use fresh leaves in iced drinks and jellies, dried leaves in potpourri and sachets
