PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial Grass
Height / Width:	5 ft. H x 5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, arching clump
Flower / Fruit:	Long plumes of purplish-black flowers held just above foliage, maturing to yellow in fall, brown in winter
Leaf:	Long, bright dark green, glossy
Native To:	Eastern Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-24
Soil:	Fast draining, poor, sandy
Water:	Moderate
Sun:	Full sun to part shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back in winter, remove flower plumes before seeds mature to control re-seeding tendency

Rock gardens, slopes and banks, used in flower arrangements both fresh and dried
