#### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>6 in.-1 ft. H x 2 - 3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Spreading</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Crowded spikes of very showy 1-inch violet blue blossoms</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Glossy green foliage</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Dry hills of Calif. coastal ranges</b>

#### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>7-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well-drained; grows in clay or decomposed granite, always on slopes</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Drought tolerant</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Deadhead regularly to induce flowering all summer. Plants live for 20 or more years with no care or maintenance; do not overwater or fertilize!</b>
