GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Days to Harvest: 75 - 80 days

Soil: Fertile, well drained
pH 5.5 - 6.8

Water: Keep soil moist

Sun: Full sun

PLANT DESCRIPTION

The largest of the chile peppers, with medium-hot fruits measuring 10-12 in. long and weighing up to 4 oz.! The best we've found for Chiles Rellenos. An old "tried and true" variety, now making a comeback. Sturdy 24-36 in. tall plants yield 24-30 pods per plant which tend to ripen all at the same time. Flowers well, even when hot.
