

# Phalaris arundinacea picta 'Feeseey' Ribbon Grass



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Perennial Grass
<b>Height / Width:</b>	1½ - 2 ft. H x spreading
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Clump; spreads indefinitely by underground runners
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	White airy flower clusters, aging to pale brown
<b>Leaf:</b>	Flat, arching, green and white striped, 6-12-in.-long blades (2/3 in. wide); pink tinged in spring, creamy white by summer
<b>Native To:</b>	North America, Eurasia

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	1-10,14-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Tolerates moist, wet conditions, or well-drained garden soil
<b>Water:</b>	Moderate to regular
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun or partial shade in hottest climates
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	To keep plant in-bounds in wet areas, grow in large containers or use control methods as for running bamboos

**GARDEN USE** Dense, weed-free groundcover in areas where invasiveness is not a concern. Boggy areas, water gardens (submerged in several inches of water).
