

# Phygелиus x rectus 'African Queen' Cape Fuchsia



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	3-4 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Tubular, orange flowers with yellow throat, summer to fall
Leaf:	Glossy deep green
Native To:	South Africa (Hybrid)

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-9, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Part shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Spreads slowly by under-ground stems. Cut out old flower stalks after bloom to keep plants neat. Mulch roots in cold winter areas.

## GARDEN USE

Adds luscious color to garden. Attracts birds. Deer love to eat! Pair with maroon and yellow plants (*Coreopsis*, *Heuchera*)
