

# Phygelius x rectus 'Moonraker' Cape Fuchsia



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	4 ft. H x 4+ ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump, fast-growing
Flower / Fruit:	Showy lazy clusters of long, nodding, solid pale yellow tubular flowers that cover the plant all summer long into fall
Leaf:	4-in. long, deep green, ovate
Native To:	South Africa (Hybrid)

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4 – 9, 14 - 24
Soil:	Moist, fertile, well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Part shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Spreads slowly by underground stems. Cut out old flower stalks after bloom to keep plants neat. Mulch roots in cold winter areas.
