PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen Tree

Height / Width: 30-60 ft. H x 30-60 ft. W

Plant Form: An ornamentally attractive oak with trunk and main limbs covered with handsome, thick, corky bark.

Flower / Fruit: Narrow oval-oblong acorns (to 1.25" long).

Leaf Color, Size: Toothed, 3" oval leaves are shiny dark green above, grey below

Native To: Western Mediterranean, No. Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 5-7, 8-16, 18-24

Soil: Acidic, well-drained

Water: Dry to medium, tolerates some drought

Sun: Full sun

Care and Pruning: A low maintenance, long-lived tree.

GARDEN USE Large oak for streets, residential areas and parks.
