| Plant Type: | Evergreen shrub |
| Height / Width: | 3-15 ft. H x 8 ft. W |
| Plant Form: | Upright (in woodlands). Low spreading (near ocean) |
| Flower / Fruit: | Green pea-sized berries turn red to black as they ripen |
| Leaf Color, Size: | Narrow, dark green |
| Native To: | California, SW Oregon, Arizona |

| Sunset Zones: | 3a-10, 14-24 |
| Soil: | Tolerant of many types |
| Water: | Established plants need no irrigation |
| Sun: | Full sun; partial shade in hottest climates |
| Care & Pruning: | Tolerant of pruning & shaping |
