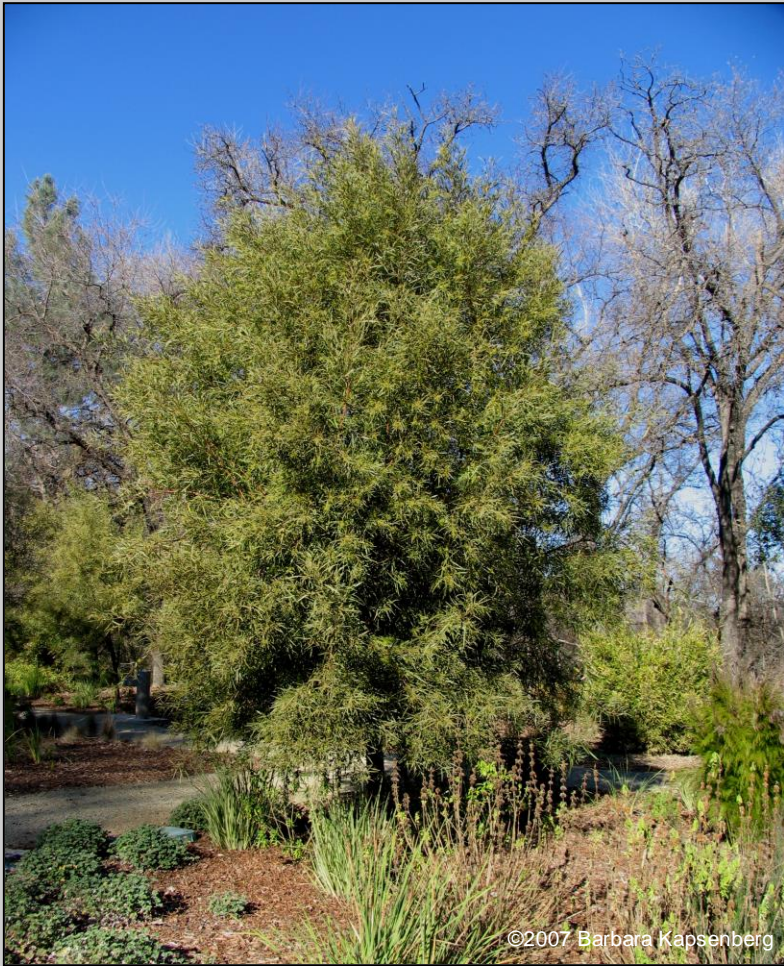


Rhus lancea

African Sumac



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Tree
Height / Width:	20-30 ft. H x 20-35 ft. W
Plant Form:	Open, spreading with graceful, weeping outer branchlets. Slow-grower.
Flower / Fruit:	Inconspicuous spring flowers. Pea-size yellow or red fruit. (Can be messy).
Leaf Color/Size:	Dark green, divided into three willowlike, 4-5 in.-long leaflets.
Native To:	South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8, 9, 12-24
Soil:	Any, as long as drainage is good
Water:	Little to moderate
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Can be trained to single trunk or grow as multitrunked tree, somewhat resembling olive.

GARDEN USE

Specimen, background or screen. Can be clipped into a hedge.
