PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Shrub Rose

Height/Width: 6 ft. H x 3 ft. W

Plant Form: Shrub or short climber

Flower / Fruit: Single, open flower, 2½" across, with 5 petals. No noticeable fragrance

Leaf: Very small green leaves with tiny thorns on the underside.

Native To: Species

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 1-24

Soil: Well drained soil

Water: Low

Sun: Part shade to full shade

Care and Pruning: Light pruning in spring resulting in healthy strong stems, to produce a maximum number flowers

GARDEN USE Can be trained to climb on fences, trellises or pillars.
Disease and heat tolerant.
