Memorial Rose



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Trailing Rose

Height/Width: 12" H x 15+ ft. W

Plant Form: Ground Cover

Flower /Fruit: Fragrant midsummer flowers are white, to 2" across, held in clusters

Leaf: Trailing stems grow 10-12 ft. long in one season, and take root in contact with moist soil

Native To: Japan, Korean, eastern China

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 3-9, 12-24

Soil: Average

Water: Moderate – Regular
(growth faster with more water)

Sun: Full sun to part shade

Care and Pruning: If needed, cut back annually after bloom to control size

GARDEN USE Good ground cover even in relatively poor soil
